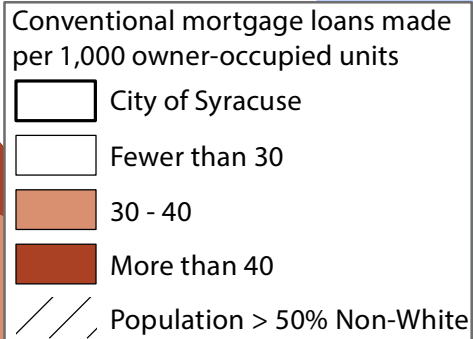
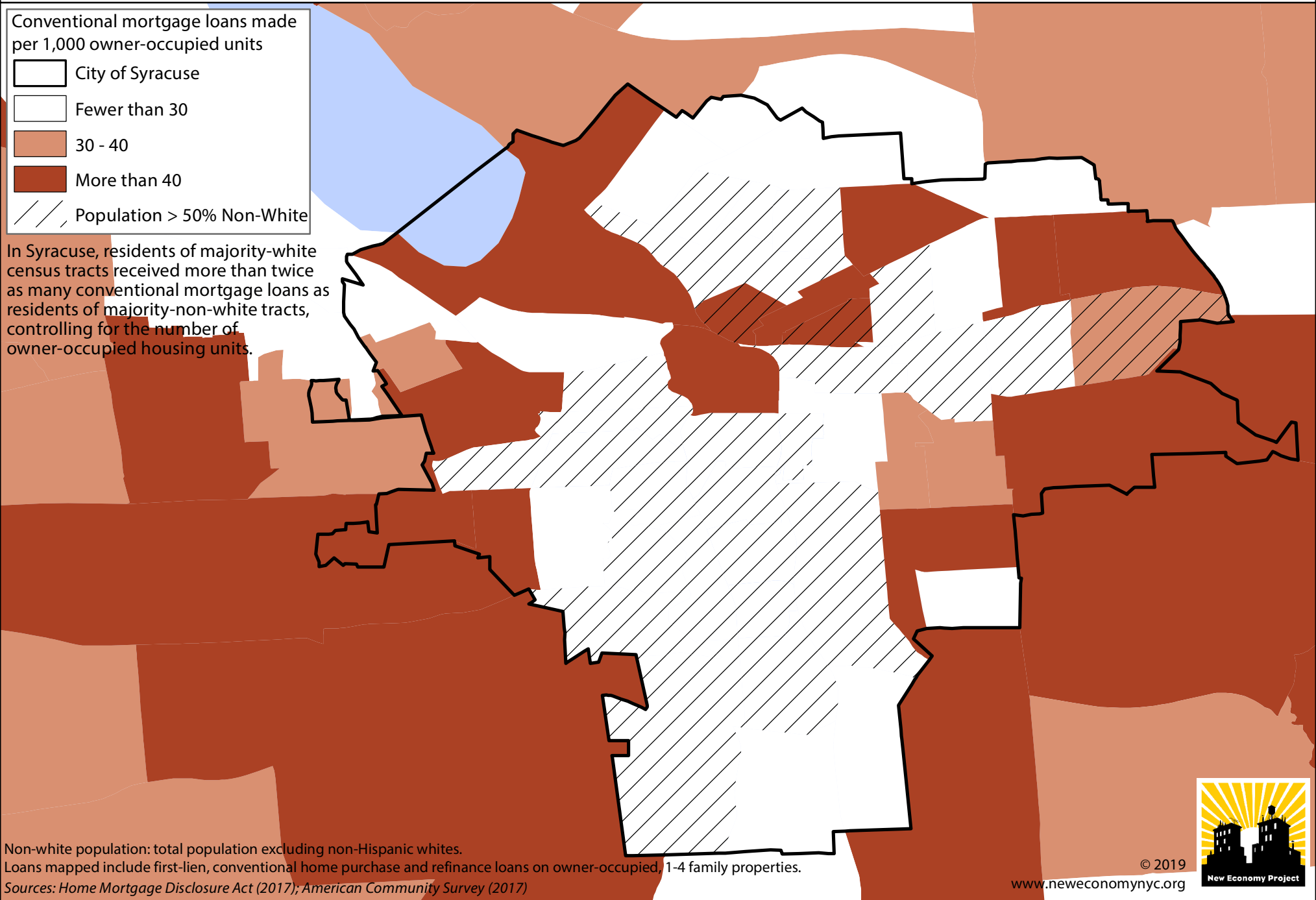


Mortgage Lending Disparities by Race and Ethnicity Syracuse, NY - 2017



In Syracuse, residents of majority-white census tracts received more than twice as many conventional mortgage loans as residents of majority-non-white tracts, controlling for the number of owner-occupied housing units.



Non-white population: total population excluding non-Hispanic whites.

Loans mapped include first-lien, conventional home purchase and refinance loans on owner-occupied, 1-4 family properties.
